As we enter the month of April, we'll leave Easter Sunday behind in March. But the Easter season is just beginning.

From now until Mother's Day (May 12), we'll spend each Sunday asking the same question the disciples surely asked many times: "What now?"

Jesus was resurrected...so what? Does the resurrection of Jesus mean anything for our community, our church, our world? Does the resurrection mean anything for your life? Christians answer all of these questions with a resounding, "YES!"

Our sermons will follow the Lectionary readings for each Sunday. Here is a preview of what's to come:

- April 7th. "That You May Believe." (John 20:19-31)
- April 14th. "This was Always the Plan." (Acts 3:1-26).
- April 21st. "Companions of Jesus." (Acts 4:5-13).
- April 28th. "Tell the Story." (Acts 8:36-40).

If you're able, I'd encourage you to look up the other Lectionary passages for each week. They always add some interesting context and draw out themes you might otherwise miss. Just search "Revised Common Lectionary" followed by the date.

May God fill you with hope in this Easter season, and may you, in the words of the apostle Paul, more deeply "know Christ and the power of his resurrection" (Philippians 3:10).
